The Chelsea School District will once again provide the option to our parents of purchasing a student accident insurance plan for the 2016-17 school year. In order to enroll for this additional insurance coverage go to www.1stAgency.com. On the right hand side of the screen in the box titled "K-12 School" select the State and click on "Go". From there find Chelsea School District and click on the "Purchase Coverage" link under our name. If you would like to view the entire policy prior to signing up, follow the link that comes up when you click on "Purchase Coverage" or you can go to the District Web Site at www.chelsea.k12.mi.us and click on the Athletic Department the entire policy can be found (in PDF format) under the "Forms" link.

Parents may sign up for this coverage throughout the year. **To ensure that your child is covered from the first day of school, your enrollment packet (with payment) must be received by First Agency, Inc. by September 6, 2016.** Enrollments coming in after this date will only be effective from the point at which the enrollment form was turned in and the full price of the policy will still be charged.

Optional football coverage is available and has different effective dates. **In addition, if you opt to purchase tackle football coverage the policy must be purchased prior to the first day of practice (August 1, 2016).** Again, enrollments coming in after this date will only be effective from the point at which the enrollment form was turned in and the full price of the policy will still be charged.

If you are looking for additional insurance coverage, you may review the coverage options available under the MICHild programs. MICHild is a health insurance program for uninsured children of Michigan's working families. In order to learn more about MICHild please visit the following website:
